TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME GREETING:

Whereas, In the Court of Common Pleas in and for the County of Montgomery held at Norristown in said County [REDACTED] a certain [REDACTED] was convicted of the crime(s) of Delivery of a Controlled Substance (F) and the said Court [REDACTED] thereupon sentenced him to twenty-eight days to twenty-three months jail, two years probation and to pay costs. [REDACTED] his attorney filed a motion to vacate the sentence and plea in this case. The motion asked the Court to vacate the sentence on the grounds due to the passage of time and the joinder of the Commonwealth. On the same date, the District Attorney of Montgomery County filed a joinder, indicating the District Attorney joined in the petition to vacate his sentence in this case. Instead, a conviction for Disorderly Conduct (S) would be imposed. The Commonwealth agreed that he would not be sentenced to a further penalty. [REDACTED] the judge ordered that [REDACTED] guilty plea [REDACTED] be vacated and he was found guilty of Disorderly Conduct (S). Fines and costs were paid in full.

And Whereas, The Board of Pardons, after full hearing, upon due public notice, and in open session, have recommended to me, in writing, with the reasons therefor, the pardon of the said [REDACTED] which recommendation and reasons have been filed in the office of the Lieutenant Governor.

Therefore, know ye, That in consideration of the premises and by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution, I have pardoned the said [REDACTED] of the crime(s) whereof he was convicted as aforesaid, and he is hereby thereof fully pardoned accordingly.
